Re: Testing Rule

In the interest of clarity, the following adjustments to the Regulations as detailed below are in effect immediately and replace and amplify article 6.2 in its entirety.

- **6.2 Approved Testing** Testing is not permitted except as described in this Regulation and must comply with the following provisions:
- A. The Driver must have completed all required license/membership requirements and be approved to participate.
- B. The Entrant must have completed all required license/membership requirements and be approved to participate.
- C. Beginning February 1st and until the end of the last round of the 2010 season, testing is permitted for Championship Class participants at USF2000 National Championship approved "Official" test Events including promoter test days.
- D. Beginning February 1st and until the end of the last round of the 2010 season, testing is NOT permitted for Championship Class participants at any track which has yet to hold a round of the 2010 USF2000 National Championship Series.
- E. Championship Class participants may test and/or compete at SCCA Club Race Events and other Pro F2000 Series Race Events at Event facilities not otherwise prohibited in these regulations.
- F. Any team desiring to conduct a private "Unofficial" test in accordance with Rule 6 must notify the Series office no later than 10 days prior to

- commencement of any such test and provide details of test on the Testing Registration Form in order to receive permission from the Series.
- G. The Series reserves the right to send a representative to any Unofficial Test to check compliance with the USF2000 Regulations and the Competitor must co-operate fully with the representative's checks.
- H. Penalties for a violation of the Testing Regulations may include the loss of any points and prize money, the loss of the privilege to participate in the Event at the track where the prohibited testing occurred, the loss of Championship points and/or a financial penalty or other penalty.
- I. Beyond these Regulations, there are no limits on the number of test days that may be undertaken.
- J. Testing is not restricted for National Class participants.
