Pro Mazda Championship Presented by Cooper Tires

The Pro Mazda Championship Presented by Cooper Tires debuts as a new series in 2013, replacing the Star Mazda Championship which ceased operations in 2012 after 22 years. Sanctioned by INDYCAR, the series is the second step on the Mazda Road to Indy ladder system bridging the gap between the Cooper Tires USF2000 Championship Powered by Mazda and Firestone Indy Lights.

Pro Mazda utilizes the same equipment as the former Star Mazda Series and continues the tradition of awarding a scholarship from Mazda for the series' champion to advance to Firestone Indy Lights in 2014. Graduates of Star Mazda include IZOD IndyCar Series drivers Marco Andretti, James Hinchcliffe and Graham Rahal, NASCAR veteran Michael McDowell, BMW Motorsport factory driver Joey Hand, and rising star Conor Daly amongst many others.

Frenchman Tristan Vautier, who won the title in 2011, will graduate to the IZOD IndyCar Series this season after winning last year's Firestone Indy Lights Championship, while 2012 champion Jack Hawksworth, from England, is looking to follow in his footsteps by stepping up into Indy Lights for 2013.

CARS:

The Pro Mazda Championship Presented by Cooper Tires features open-wheel, single-seat, open-cockpit cars with front and rear wings. The carbon fiber chassis, which was introduced in 2004, is built to FIA standards.

Sunoco is the Official Fuel of Pro Mazda.

ENGINES:

Pro Mazda utilizes the Mazda Renesis rotary engine as remanufactured and serviced by SpeedSource Race Engineering. The engine generates approximately 260 horsepower – 90 horsepower more than a USF2000 Mazda MZR powerplant – and is capable of powering cars to speeds of 160 mph.

TIRES

Slick/rain tires co-branded COOPER/PROMAZDA as manufactured by Cooper Tires.

PRIZEMONEY

The Pro Mazda Championship Presented by Cooper Tires will distribute over \$1,000,000 in prizes and awards in 2013. The series' champion will receive a scholarship package from Mazda and a prize package from INDYCAR to advance to Firestone Indy Lights competition in 2014.

Points are awarded for pole position, most laps led and fastest race lap.

The qualifying field for the second race of a two-race event will be determined by the second fastest qualifying lap time or the fastest race lap time from the first race, whichever is faster.

ADDITIONAL BENEFITS

The Mazda Road to Indy Summit and Oval Clinic is a three-part educational and promotional program held during the season. The platform provides valuable education on a variety of topics including marketing/business, media training, career growth and development, fitness and wellness, social media and a comprehensive introduction to oval track racing led by industry experts. It also features activities such as high-profile autograph sessions and fan Q&A's, networking reception, team owner meet-and-greets, race shop tours and pace laps around the Indianapolis Motor Speedway with IZOD IndyCar Series drivers. Additionally, the winner of the "Night Before the 500" will pace the Firestone Freedom 100 Indy Lights field on Carburetion Day and be interviewed in front of the Indianapolis 500 crowd only minutes before the race.

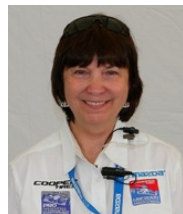

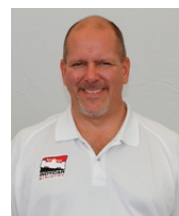

Linares Racing was the first Venezuelan team to participate in the Mazda Road to Indy program, and it is one of only a handful of teams that won a Star Mazda race in 2012. Its victory came in the rain at Edmonton, Alberta, Canada in July with rookie Camilo Schmidt behind the wheel. The team was founded and is owned by the Linares family, which has a long legacy in the sport. The team also has a keen appreciation for what a young driver needs to develop, since it is operated by two brothers who are rising stars themselves: Carlos and Gustavo Linares. Although they've successfully worked with drivers from various nationalities, they are especially adept at bridging the gap for Hispanic drivers who wish to tackle the various Mazda Road to Indy series. The team moved from Brownsburg, Ind., to Fort Lauderdale, Fla., during the winter of 2012-2013 in order to be closer to the Hispanic community in Florida and for the increased opportunity for testing in the Sunshine State. Cooper Tires USF2000 Championship Powered by Mazda

The Cooper Tires USF2000 Championship Powered by Mazda debuted in 2010 and is a revival of the highly regarded USF2000 series which ran from 1990 through 2006, launching the careers of many of today's top drivers. Sanctioned by INDYCAR, the series is the first official step on the Mazda Road to Indy - a clearly defined path to reach the top echelons of the sport.

In addition to providing a vital training ground for rising stars, the top driver in the Championship Class will earn a scholarship package from Mazda to advance to the Pro Mazda Championship, the next step on the ladder system. The series is also part of the *MAZDASPEED* Motorsports Development program which assists young drivers in advancing from the Skip Barber Racing School to USF2000.

The series is open to drivers age 15 and up (with 14-year-olds eligible pending review and acceptance of a driving resume by the series and approval by INDYCAR). Drivers who have honed their skills in USF2000 include Indy 500 winners Dan Wheldon, Sam Hornish Jr. and Buddy Rice, rising stars JR Hildebrand and Charlie Kimball, and sports car talents Andy Lally, Memo Rojas and Memo Gidley.

CARS:

There are two classes of competition within the USF2000 series – Championship and National.

The Championship Class features open-wheel, single-seat, open-cockpit cars with front and rear wings. As a cost constraint, the rules package requires a one-make chassis. Only Van Diemen Elan cars manufactured from 2001 on are eligible to compete. This allows teams to amortize their purchase over multiple years. The cars are low-budget, easy to work on mechanically and offer multiple tuning adjustments with cornering speeds matching the next level car (Pro Mazda). The cars are powered by the Mazda MZR 2-liter powerplant – a four-cylinder, double-overhead cam, fuel-injected engine generating approximately 170 horsepower and capable of powering cars to speeds of 150 mph. All Mazda MZR engines are prepared and sealed by Elite Engines of West Bend, Wis.

The USF2000 National Class Presented by SCCA Enterprises offers a cost-effective alternative program with the opportunity for advancement to the Championship Class. National Class Mazda-powered Van Diemens are open-wheel, single-seat, open-cockpit SCCA Enterprises' Formula Enterprises (FE) cars with slightly less horsepower. The rules package closely mirrors the SCCA General Competition Rules and Specifications (GCR) currently in place with minor changes including expanding the allowable spring options, permitting an alternate sway bar and the use of wickers on the front and rear wings, and replacing the muffler with a straight tailpipe.

Sunoco is the Official Fuel of USF2000.

TIRES

Thirteen-inch slick and rain tires co-branded COOPER/USF2000 as manufactured by Cooper Tires are mandatory in both classes.

PRIZEMONEY

The Cooper Tires USF2000 Championship Powered by Mazda will distribute over \$518,000 in prizes and awards in 2013. The winner of the Championship Class will receive a scholarship package from Mazda to advance to Pro Mazda competition in 2014. The winner of the National Class will receive a scholarship to advance to the Championship Class the following year.

Bonus points are awarded for pole position, most laps led and fastest race lap.

The qualifying field for the second race of a two-race event will be determined by the second fastest qualifying lap time or the fastest race lap time from the first race, whichever is faster.

ADDITIONAL BENEFITS

The Mazda Road to Indy Summit and Oval Clinic is a three-part educational and promotional program held during the season. The platform provides valuable education on a variety of topics including marketing/business, media training, career growth and development, fitness and wellness, social media and a comprehensive introduction to oval track racing led by industry experts. It also features activities such as high-profile autograph sessions and fan Q&A's, networking reception, team owner meet-and-greets, race shop tours and pace laps around the Indianapolis Motor Speedway with IZOD IndyCar Series drivers. Additionally, the winner of the "Night Before the 500" will pace the Firestone Freedom 100 Indy Lights field on Carburetion Day and be interviewed in front of the Indianapolis 500 crowd only minutes before the race.
