ABOUT USF PRO CHAMPIONSHIPS PRESENTED BY COOPER TIRES

The newly rebranded USF Pro Championships Presented by Cooper Tires is an evolution of the Road to Indy, one of the most successful driver development programs in the world. Comprised of USF Pro 2000 Presented by Cooper Tires, USF2000 Presented by Cooper Tires and USF Juniors Presented by Cooper Tires, the ladder system provides a scholarship-funded path to the top levels of motorsports.

The 2022 NTT INDYCAR SERIES grid was peppered with graduates of the ladder system – including Conor Daly, Devlin DeFrancesco, Jack Harvey, Colton Herta, Dalton Kellett, Kyle Kirkwood, David Malukas, Josef Newgarden, Pato O'Ward, Felix Rosenqvist, Sage Karam and Rinus VeeKay amongst others – while 20 of the 33 starters in the Indianapolis 500 were alumni.

The racing world in general also featured series graduates including Oliver Askew, Austin Cindric, Gabby Chaves, Conor DePhillippi, Pipo Derani, Dakota Dickerson, Jack Hawksworth, Trent Hindman, Andy Lally, Michael McDowell, Bryan Sellers, Aaron Telitz, Parker Thompson and Tristan Vautier – all competing at the premier level in a variety of disciplines.

Since its launch in 2010, the ladder system has attracted competitors from around the globe with drivers representing 37 countries and six continents as part of its grids, showcasing their talents at premier venues on a mix of road courses, temporary street circuits and ovals.

The USF Pro Championships provide its competitors an opportunity to gain valuable experience on and off the track while following a clear-cut path of progression.



USF PRO CHAMPIONSHIPS



The newly rebranded USF Pro 2000 Presented by Cooper Tires (formerly Indy Pro 2000) has served as a vital step on the career path of many of today's top drivers. It is the third official step on the USF Pro Championships ladder.

USF Pro 2000's roots date back to 1991 with the Star Mazda Championship, which ceased operation in 2012 after 22 years. Andersen Promotions founded what is now USF Pro 2000 in December of 2012 to replace the void left by Star Mazda. Graduates include Oliver Askew, Conor Daly, James Hinchcliffe, Sage Karam, Kyle Kirkwood, David Malukas, Patricio O'Ward, Graham Rahal, Sting Ray Robb and Rinus VeeKay as well as reigning INDY NXT champion Linus Lundqvist.



USF2000 Presented by Cooper Tires debuted in 2010 and is a continuation of the highly regarded USF2000 series which ran from 1990 through 2006, launching the careers of many of today's top drivers. The series is the second official step of USF Pro Championships.

Drivers who have honed their skills in the series include Oliver Askew, Matthew Brabham, Colton Herta, JR Hildebrand, Sage Karam, Kyle Kirkwood, Andy Lally, Hunter McElrea, Christian Rasmussen, Bryan Sellers, Parker Thompson and Rinus VeeKay to name a few.



USF Juniors Presented by Cooper Tires is the first official step on the USF Pro Championships Presented by Cooper Tires driver development system.

Debuting in 2022, USF Juniors provides an entry level program for young drivers needing more experience and track time before moving onto the highly competitive USF2000 platform. The series brings a level of professionalism and organization to a driver's first serious championship choice. Emphasis is placed on training - with a "teaching" staff second to none - in addition to providing an environment for great competition.



The same base Tatuus chassis is utilized in all three levels of USF Pro Championships, allowing drivers and teams to begin with the USF Juniors JR-23 and continue to advance up the world's most complete driver development system with a forward-thinking three-step concept.

The equipment package will remain in competition for at least five more seasons through 2027.



THE CHASSIS

Tatuus is world-renowned as a premier builder of formula cars. The USF Pro Championships concept is unique in that the same monocoque and many of the main suspension and bodywork components are common to all three series.

The chassis is a full carbon composite and aluminum honeycomb monocoque meeting current FIA safety standards including side impact panels, front and rear impact structures, HANS-compliant INDYCAR head restraint, front and rear wheel tethers and an upgraded front bulkhead structure for USA-specific oval racing circuits and a Halo-type device.
